The contents of this message pertain to two clients our compliance firm manages: Citizens for Munoz (Committee ID 9487) and the Chicago Reform Caucus (Committee ID 23767). The Citizens for Munoz disclosed a \$50,000 contribution from the SEIU Illinois Council in an A-1 report filed on September 13, 2013. It has come to our attention that contribution was incorrectly reported under the wrong committee name. Citizens for Munoz did not receive \$50,000 from the SEIU Illinois Council, and thus, this contribution will not appear on the committee's upcoming quarterly report. Moreover, the committee that did in fact receive \$50,000 from the SEIU Illinois Council was the Chicago Reform Caucus. As such, the aforementioned erroneous A-1 was intended to be filed by the Chicago Reform Caucus. Per the instructions given to us by the analyst at the IL Board of Elections in a phone conversation on 9/16/13, we have filed an A-1 Report on behalf of the Chicago Reform Caucus disclosing a \$50,000 contribution from the SEIU Illinois Council. We request that the copies of this letter be attached to the committee files of both Citizens for Munoz and the Chicago Reform Caucus. Internally, we have corrected the system error to ensure this does not occur again. Lastly, we apologize for this unintentional error and would like to note that as soon as the discrepancy was known to us, we took immediate steps to remedy the situation.
