STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MEETING

The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct its regularly scheduled monthly Board Meeting on **MONDAY, JULY 21, 2014**.

The meeting will begin at 10:30 a.m. in the Board's principal office located at 2329 S. MacArthur Boulevard, Springfield, IL and via video conference in Suite 14-100 of the James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, IL. Admittance to the 14<sup>th</sup> floor of the Thompson Center requires security screening and production of a government issued identification.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to address pending litigation, complaints following closed hearing and/or personnel matters.
