
As you are aware from your earlier discussions with my colleague, Carol Lockwood, this office represents the Northern Illinois Building Contractors Association, an Illinois 501(c)(6) not-for-profit corporation. This letter is to supplement the information provided in Carol's letter to you of March 15, 2006.

In keeping with your discussions with Carol, we understand that, at present, there are no set requirements for the submission of Schedule A-1 reports by the not-for-profit entities.
