SIGNATURE
REQUIREMENTS: At least 100 of the primary electors of his or her party in his or her congressional district. Refer to page 35, Nomination of Established Political Party Candidates. [10 ILCS 5/7-10 (f)]

ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION: * State Central Committeemen for the Republican Party will not be on the March 2010 Primary Ballot. They will be elected at the county conventions pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/7-8, Alternative A.

Democratic and Green Parties - In each congressional district at the primary election, the male candidate receiving the highest number of votes of the party's male candidates for State Central Committeeman, and the female candidates receiving the highest number of votes of the party's female candidate for State Central Committeewoman, shall be declared elected State Central Committeeman, and State Central Committeewoman from the district. If all Candidates for State Central Committeeman from a congressional district are of the same sex, the candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected a State Central Committeeman from the district, and because of a failure to elect one male and one female to the committee, a vacancy shall be declared to exist in the office of the second member of the State Central Committee from the district. This vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the Congressional Committee of the political party, and the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall be a resident of the congressional district and of the sex opposite that of the committeeman elected at the primary election. (10ILCS 5/7-8)
