<p><b>Early Voting</b></p>	<p>Extended to the 2<sup>nd</sup> day preceding the election for all jurisdictions at the 2014 General Election  <b>October 20 – November 2, 2014</b></p>		
<p><b>Grace Period Registration and Voting</b></p>	<p>Extended to the close of the polls on Election Day for all jurisdictions at the 2014 General Election  <b>October 8 – November 4, 2014</b></p>		
<p><b>Absentee Voting</b></p>	<p>First day to apply:  <b>August 6</b></p>	<p>First day for mailing and delivery:  <b>September 25</b></p>	<p>Must be postmarked by midnight on:  <b>November 3</b></p>
<p>Permanent Polling Places for Election Authorities in counties with a population over 250,000</p>		<p><b><u>Permanent Polling Place Hours</u></b>  Weekdays:  8:30AM – 4:30 PM or 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM  Saturdays and Holidays:  9:00 AM – 12:00 PM  Sundays:  10:00 AM – 4:00 PM  <b>Weekdays After October 28<sup>th</sup>:</b>  8:30 AM – 7:00 PM or 9:00 AM – 7:00 PM  Final Weekend Before Election (Nov 1-2)  Specific hours determined by EA*  *Must be open a minimum of 14 hours during final weekend before the election</p>	
<p><u>Applies To:</u>  Cook County  DuPage County  McHenry County  Will County  Lake County  Madison County  St. Clair County  Winnebago County  Kane County</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must establish at least one PERMANENT polling place for early and grace period voting within each of the three largest municipalities</li> <li>• If any of the three largest municipalities is over 80,000, EA must establish two PERMANENT polling places within the municipality</li> <li>• Additional temporary branch polling places may be established. Schedules of temporary polling places can be set at the discretion of the EA.</li> </ul>		
<p>Permanent Polling Places for Boards of Election Commissioners with a population over 100,000</p>		<p><b><u>Public University Voting</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must conduct early voting in a high traffic area on campus of public university</li> <li>• Must conduct in-person absentee voting on election day in high traffic area of campus, hours to be determined by EA</li> </ul> <p><u>Applies To:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign and Springfield</li> <li>• Southern Illinois University in Carbondale and Edwardsville <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eastern Illinois University</li> <li>• Illinois State University</li> <li>• Northern Illinois University</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Western Illinois University in Macomb and Moline</li> </ul>	
<p><u>Applies To:</u>  Chicago  Peoria  Aurora  Rockford</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must establish at least two PERMANENT polling places for early and grace period voting</li> <li>• Additional temporary branch polling places may be established.
