SPRINGFIELD, IL, November 27, 2002 - The Illinois State Board of Elections today released figures that show just over 40 percent of public questions on the November general election ballot gained enough votes for passage.

Of 307 referenda proposals, 44 percent or 135 passed and 172 failed.

Tax issues fared the poorest with more failing than passing. 118 failed and 63 were approved.
