The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct a **SPECIAL** Board Meeting on **Tuesday, January 17, 2012.**

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Board's conference room 14-100 in the James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, IL and via video conference at the Board's principal office located at 1020 S. Spring St., Springfield, IL. Admittance to the 14th floor of the Thompson Center requires security screening and production of a government issued identification.

The State Board of Elections will convene to certify established party Congressional candidates for the March 20, 2012 General Primary Election; consider a proposed settlement to the consent decree between the SBE and Department of Justice; and consider the candidate withdrawal of Thomas J. Carroll, Cook County 3rd Subcircuit, Moore vacancy.

The State Officers Electoral Board will convene to consider objections to the following candidate nominating petitions:

- a) *McSweeney v. Gaffney*, 11SOEBGP502;
- b) *Woods v. Maurice*, 11SOEBGP510;
- c) *Montgomery/Williams v. Letke*, 11SOEBGP520; and

to consider subpoena request in connection with challenges to nomination petitions of the following congressional candidates:

- a) *Bromley v. Evans*, 12SOEBGP100;and
- b) *Schaefflein/Brezinski v. Cunningham*, 12SOEBGP525.

The State Officer's Electoral Board will recess to the State Board of Elections and may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to consider litigation and/or personnel matters.
