STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MEETING

The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct its regularly scheduled monthly Board Meeting on **TUESDAY, JUNE 17, 2014**.

The meeting will begin at 10:30 a.m. in Room 9-040 in the James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, IL and via video conference at the Board's principal office located at 2329 S. MacArthur Boulevard, Springfield, IL. Admittance to the 9<sup>th</sup> floor of the Thompson Center requires security screening and production of a government issued identification.

The Board will convene as the State Officers Electoral Board to approve the Rules of Procedures, appointment of hearing officers and call and accept appearances for the following objections to resolutions to fill vacancies in nomination for the November 4, 2014 General Election:

- a. *Farrar & Peters v. Chaplin*, 14SOEBGE500;
- b. *Venturi & Daniel v. Mains*, 14SOEBGB501;
- c. *Ramsey v. Granata*, 14SOEBGE502;
- d. *Crowder v. Ruocco*, 14SOEBGE503;
- e. *Rodriguez v. Russell*, 14SOEBGE504;
- f. *Peterson v. Kolber*, 14SOEBGE505

The Board will consider: a motion for clarification of settlement offer, appeals, complaints, assessments/final orders and civil penalty payments; an update on constitutional amendment petitions; disposition of Term Limits and Reform petition; resolutions to fill vacancies in nomination and independent and new party petition filing period updates; counting of SERS Trustee ballots; a legislative update; paperless online voter application and IVRS updates; and comparison of census data versus number of registered voters in certain jurisdictions.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to address pending litigation, complaints following closed hearing and/or personnel matters.
