STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MEETING

The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct its regularly scheduled monthly Board Meeting on **Friday, August 24, 2018**.

The meeting will begin at **10:30 a.m.** in Room 9-040 in the James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, IL and via video conference at the Board's principal office located at 2329 S. MacArthur Boulevard, Springfield, IL. Admittance to the 9th floor of the Thompson Center requires security screening and production of a government issued identification.

The Board will reconvene as the State Officers Electoral Board to consider the following objections to independent and new party candidate nominating petitions for the November 6, 2018 General Election:

- c) *Dittmer, Bos v. Murphy*, 18SOEBGE500;

- f) *Hosty v. Walls*, 18SOEBGE504;
- g) *Lard v. Goldberg*, 18SOEBGE507;
- h) *McKinny v. Murphy*, 18SOEBGE508.

The Board will certify the ballot for the November 6, 2018 General Election. The Board will also consider campaign disclosure settlement offers, appeals, random audits of political committees and complaints; proposed administrative rules for the Cyber Navigator Program; a presentation from Equip for Equality; legislative, IVRS/IT, automatic voter registration and cyber navigator program updates; and updates to the SBE Policy Manual - Harassment & Anti-Bullying.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to address pending litigation, complaints following closed hearing and/or personnel matters.
