
Admittance to the James R. Thompson Center requires security screening and government identification of all visitors.

The Board will reconvene as the State Officers Electoral Board to approve minutes from the July 26, August 6, 17 and 27 meetings.

The Board will convene as the State Board of Elections to consider: a modification to the Dominion voting system; the Interstate Voter Registration Data Crosscheck program; a Demonstration of MOVE website; the Voter Awareness and Public Information Program; a report on election judge training schools; a report on the Advisory Committee Meeting; an IVRS update; Cost Control and Spending Reduction Plan; a lump sum update; a legislative update; campaign disclosure related complaints, settlement offers, civil penalty payments, hearings, and appeals.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to consider litigation and/or personnel matters.
