PUBLIC NOTICE OF STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND STATE OFFICERS ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING

The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct its regularly scheduled monthly Board Meeting on **Monday, September 17, 2012.**

The meeting will begin at **10:30 a.m.** in the Board's principal office located at 2329 S. MacArthur Blvd., Springfield, IL and may be attended in Suite 14-100 of the James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, IL via videoconference. Attendance at the Thompson Center requires security screening and production of a government issued identification.

The Board will convene as the State Officers Electoral Board to adopt the Rules of Procedure and consider the following objections to candidate nomination for the November 6, 2012 General Election;

- a. *Martin v. Obama*, 12SOEBGE111;
- b. *Freeman v. Obama*, 12SOEBGE112;
- c. *Jackson v. Obama*, 12SOEBGE113.

The Board will consider campaign disclosure related complaints, civil penalty payments, hearings, appeals and settlement offers; candidate withdrawal and appointment of Green Party nominee for U.S. Vice President; Federal Consent Decree/UOCAVA update; voting system pre-testing and election judge training schools; consideration of approval of Dominion's ImageCast In-Precinct and the ImageCast Central Count voting system; legislative update and reports on Advisory Committee and Campaign Finance Reform Task Force meetings; an IVRS update and census data versus registered voter comparison; and a proposed date for the December Board meeting.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess again into executive session to address litigation, committees selected for random audit and/or personnel matters.
