Attached are two lists of candidate committees which are impacted by the following section of the law:

*Section 5/9-30. Ballot forfeiture. The State Board of Elections shall not certify the name of any person who has not paid a civil penalty imposed against his or her political committee under this Article to appear upon any ballot for any office if the penalty is unpaid by the date required for certification.*

*The State Board of Elections shall generate a list of all candidates whose political committees have not paid any civil penalty assessed against them under this Article. Such list shall be transmitted to any election authority whose duty it is to place the name of any such candidate on the ballot. The election authority shall not place upon the ballot the name of any candidate appearing on this list for any office in any election while the penalty is unpaid, unless the candidate has requested a hearing and the Board has not disposed of the matter by the date of certification.*

The first list (Forfeiture List) includes candidate committees which have been issued Board Orders and have unpaid civil penalties. Those committees with an \* beside the candidate name also have matters pending on the current board agenda; therefore the amounts due may change. This list also includes some asterisked committees with single stayed violations which have appeals pending; and, if granted, will result in the removal of this committee from this ballot forfeiture list; the single penalty being stayed.

The second list (Pending List) includes candidate committees which have pending appeals, which if denied, will result in a civil penalty owed to the Board. A committee will appear on both the Pending List and the Forfeiture List if it has both a pending appeal and an unpaid civil penalty. Also on the Pending List are those candidate committees which were assessed civil penalties and which did not appeal such penalties; they will be issued Board Orders following the October board meeting.

We will be sending a Master Ballot Forfeiture list to the election authorities as soon as it is revised following the October Board meeting. We will also be sending notices to the candidates whose committees owe civil penalties. This list will be revised and updates sent as necessary.

The Illinois Campaign Finance Task Force met on Thursday, October 13, 2011 at 1:00 pm in the offices of the State Board of Elections. The agenda is attached.

A Public Finance Report (public financing of campaigns) was discussed. Task Force Member William McNary will present a rough draft to Task Force members in the next two weeks. Discussion will follow at the November 17<sup>th</sup> meeting with a vote to take place on December 15<sup>th</sup>. The report will include, but not be limited to: who would participate (judicial, statewide, or legislative candidates); where would the funding come from (tax check off, disclosure fines or other method); how does the candidate qualify (matching donations, voluntary participation), etc.

Updates and outstanding issues regarding Illinois' recently enacted campaign finance law were also discussed. Specifically, two drafts of proposed legislative changes were discussed and voted on (copies attached). The Task Force will send a report to the General Assembly asking for their consideration of these two changes in the Spring 2012 Session.

The next two meeting dates were set. They will be Thursday, November 17 and Thursday, December 15 in the State Board of Elections Springfield and Chicago offices.

## 10 ILCS 5/0-8.5 (c)

(10 ILCS 5/9-8.5)

Sec. 9-8.5. Limitations on campaign contributions.

(c) During an election cycle, a political party committee may not accept contributions with an aggregate value over the following: (i) \$10,000 from any individual, (ii) \$20,000 from any corporation, labor organization, or association, or (iii) \$50,000 from a political action committee. A political party committee may accept contributions in any amount from another political party committee or a candidate political committee, except as provided in subsection (c-5). Nothing in this Section shall limit the amounts that may be transferred between a State political party committee established under Section 7-8(a) of this Code and affiliated federal political committees established pursuant to the Federal Election Code by that same political party. A political party committee may not accept contributions from a ballot initiative committee. A political party committee established by a legislative caucus may not accept contributions from another political party committee established by a legislative caucus.



## 10 ILCS 5/9-7 (2)

(10 ILCS 5/9-7) (from Ch. 46, par. 9-7)

Sec. 9-7. (1) Except as provided in (2), The treasurer of a political committee shall keep a detailed and exact account of-

- (a) the total of all contributions made to or for the committee;
- (b) the full name and mailing address of every person making a contribution and the date and amount thereof;
- (c) the total of all expenditures made by or on behalf of the committee;
- (d) the full name and mailing address of every person to whom any expenditure is made, and the date and amount thereof;
- (e) proof of payment, stating the particulars, for every expenditure made by or on behalf of the committee.

The treasurer shall preserve all records and accounts required by this section for a period of 2 years.

(2) The treasurer shall keep a detailed and exact account of the total amount of contributions made from an event licensed pursuant to Section 8.1 of the Raffles Act. For an event licensed pursuant to Section 8.1 of the Raffles Act, the full name and mailing address of a person purchasing tickets is not required if the amount of the tickets purchased does not exceed \$20.
