HOTLINE NUMBERS

SPRINGFIELD, IL, November 6, 2006 - The Illinois State Board of Elections has set up a special Election Day “hotline” telephone number to assist voters in Tuesday’s General Election, Board officials said today.

The Chicago area “hotline” telephone number is 312/263-7367. For downstate voters, calls will be taken at the Board’s Springfield office at 217/782-4141. Telephone number for the hearing impaired is 217/782-1518.

Election specialists will be available Election Day from 6 a.m. until 11 p.m. in Chicago and from 5:30 a.m. until 1 a.m. in Springfield to answer voter questions and respond to complaints.

The polls are open from 6 a.m. until 7 p.m.

Six constitutional officers will be elected – governor and lieutenant governor (as a team), attorney general, secretary of state, comptroller and treasurer. Also on the ballot are candidates for congress, all state representatives and some state senators, county officials and judges. In addition, there are 320 referenda across the state.

Questions regarding voter registration information or polling place locations should be referred to the office of the county clerk or board of election commissioners.
