MEETING

The Illinois State Board of Elections will conduct its regularly scheduled monthly Board Meeting on **MONDAY, November 21, 2011**.

The regular meeting will begin at **10:30 a.m.** in the conference room of the State Employees' Retirement System at 2101 South Veterans Parkway in Springfield, Illinois. Video conferencing is not available at this meeting. Beginning at 10AM, Board members will meet informally for a brief review of the upcoming petition objection filing periods. This is primarily for the benefit of the newly appointed Members, and no Board action will be taken during this review.

At its regular meeting, the Board will consider: campaign disclosure related complaints, civil penalty payments, hearings and appeals; preparations for the March 20, 2012 General Primary Election including candidate petition filing, anticipated amended certification, and election judge training schools; approval of printers with ES&S ballot on demand features; electronic canvass, legislative and Campaign Finance Reform Task Force meeting updates; metes and bounds project and IVRS updates; census data versus registered voters and election management system updates; a six month review of executive session minutes; an update on the Springfield office facility; and a follow up to the questions raised at the October meeting by Mr. Andrew Finko.

The Board may address other matters as needed and/or recess into executive session to consider complaints following closed hearings, litigation and/or personnel matters.
